
MALDEN HOSPITAL.

**Dr. John L. Sullivan Favors the Plan
—Committee on Funds.**

MALDEN, Nov. 20.—A public meeting was held in the council chamber at City Hall, this evening, for the purpose of promoting the project of the proposed city hospital. Mayor Wiggin presided.

Among those present were Hon. Elisha S. Converse and wife, Alderman Joseph M. Russell, Revs J. W. Wellman T. O. Pease, J. Nelson Lewis, and Drs. John L. Sullivan, George B Sawtelle, Charles D. McCarthy, J. R. Baris, Peleg Wadsworth, A. J. Krauss, George E. Lunney, C. M. Nordstrom, W. H. Wilcox, A. H. Knights and A. G. Griffin.

Mr. Converse and several of the other gentlemen present spoke strongly in favor of the movement.

Dr. John L. Sullivan cited several instances where persons who were injured here and removed to one of the Boston hospitals had suffered terribly, and in one case a man died while being taken up on an express wagon.

Dr. Wilcox, E. S. Converse, Dr. J. L. Sullivan, E. F. Bickford, W. B. de las Casas, Mrs. E. S. Converse, Dr. Sawtelle, F. A. Smith, F. A. Robinson and Dr. Nordstrom were appointed a committee to take charge of the funds, and were given power to enlarge the committee.
