MAKES \$23,000 IN ALL

Hon. E. S. Converse's Generous Contributions to Malden Hospital.

MAIDEN, July 1—The trustees of the proposed city hospital met in the alder men's room this evening. In the absence of President E S Converse ex Major 1 1, Fuller presided William B de las Casas, secretary of the building committee, read a letter from Hon E S Converse, in which that gentleman made the liberal offer to build one of the wings of the proposed hospital, providing the committee would go on

at once with the work
The report of the building committee was
read, in which it was stated that the main
building would cost \$22,000% and that the
wings would cost about \$8000 ablee, making a total cost of \$10,000. The report of
the committee was accepted and it was
voted to authorize the committee to go on
with the work at once and to build the wing
which Mr. Converse has volunteered to pay
for.

Representative Burrett was in favor of holding another meeting within two weeks, when there may be a larger attendance of trustees so that some action could be taken as to building the other wing.

This makes \$23,000 in all that Mr Conyers has given toward the hosintal fund He also gave the site, consisting of 10 acres of high land, located near the Medford line. The trustees passed a vote of thanks for his latest generous gift

It is the intention of the building committee to set a large force of men to work at once building a road to the site and grading the grounds

Liberal citizens have already donated funds for four free beds, and the late Mrs-Haven has willed the hospital \$1000, the interest of which is to go towards maintaining another free bid
