S Converse was reelected president, Joseph F. Wiggin vice president, Harry Barrett secretary and John M. Corbett treasurer. The eight trustees were reelected for three years and Marcus Beebe was elected for two years to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Herbert Porter.
